

It may also please your mat^y that it may be enacted by your grace with y^e assent
of the lords spirituall and temporall and the commons in this present parliament assembled
and by the authority of the same y^e mayors and sherriffes of the citie of London. Coll. in
Camb. and their successors shall have and enjoy for ever out of the said manour and
of the said premises one yearly rent of ten shillings payable at y^e feast of St
Michael's Eare next and the annuall of our Lady by even portions to the
churche of St and intent and purpose that they shall pay yearly the sum of for ever
to the two fellows of the said Coll. as shall be named and appointed by your
grace your heirs and successors yearly xij. li. vi. s. and viij. d. to say to every
of y^e said two fellows 6 li. 13. s. 4. d. the two fellows a shill. in oblation after the
act take the effect as at all times hereafter for ever shall be named and appoin-
ted by your mat^y your heirs and successors for ever and after such nomination
shall followe and sheweth of and in the said Coll. according to the ordinance
of the said Coll. and shall pray for the souls etc.
And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid y^e the said yearly rent
shall be given to be kepte unpaid in parts or in all by the said space of one month
next after the end of the said feast y^e it ought to be paid y^e then it shall be
lawfull to the said m. and fellows and their successors or their assigns to
enter and distraine in the said manour and of the said premises or any parts
thereof and the distraine to retaine and keep until such time as y^e said rent
and the arrears thereof and the reasonable costs and charges about y^e
same be truly paid and contented to the said m. and fellows and their
successors as is aforesaid. It is provided althow that y^e first payment of
the said rent shall begin at y^e feast of St Michael's Eare next
and commynge.
