My own much the dearest in the
World

It is now after lunch
on Wednesday.

After you left yesterday I
packed & did up parcels for
you and Wanda and saw
Bunfitt about the greenhouse
Then the car came and I
was not ready, but I went
round and saw about the
keys and that seemed all
right. I left Agnes & Geaty
to do the real shutting up

I hope that was all right
We put Jess & the two kittens
into one of those baskets that
we bought for the water lilies
and ~~then~~ tied a bit of
sacking over the top to keep her
in. She had been getting very
fidgety with the packing.

I got off at twelve and went
to Westbrook & left your address
for forwarding letters and had
you telegram about ~~things~~ the
things for Kosula telephoned on
to me, it was only just in
time. Then I went into the town
and left the ~~you~~ cheque at

the bank and told the post
office about the letters. I got
home at one. I rested & read
some more China & then of course
went to sleep. After tea I
went for a walk on the commons
with Aunt Agnes, and I did
enjoy it, it was such a beautiful
evening and the smell of bonfires
& fire trees is so lovely.

This morning I went out in
the pony trap with Rachel.
She has not driven much and
was a little nervous at going
alone and the man was wanted
for the hay.

I do hope you have as nice
a day in Wales as we have
here, it is sunny with a
blustering West wind as usual

and quite cool.

I am glad Hasula is going
I'm sure she will enjoy it

I am feeling very well and quite
happy. It is rather nice having
nothing to do, the end of the
term was a rush although I
hadn't much of the scramble.
I have written to the police to
tell them the house is shut
up and to ask them to look
after it, especially at night.

I do wonder where you are
climbing to day. I should'nt
be surprised if you are still
sleeping after lunch its only
ten past two & one is usually
rather late with lunch. I hope
the boats are working well &
that your lumberago is hot bathing.
I've written these letters before this so
