College from y^r. Right Hon^{ble}. y^r. Earl
of Suffolk Chancellor of y^r. University
& Visitor of Magdalen College concerning
the disannulling of additions made to y^r
Statutes

Whereas it appaereth by reason of some
additions made by the means of Dr Helke
y^r. fundamental Statutes of y^r. College
are not regarded to the great prejudice
of deserving Persons, these are to abrogate
& disannull all those additions & customs
arising thence, & to make void all
such Elections as shall be made hereafter
either before the place be actually void
or before y^r. Oath by the Statutes which
to be administered be taken by every Man
that shall give his Vote, requiring
you carefully to observe y^r. fundamental
Statutes, & those of the University, as you
desire to avoid y^r. danger that may ensue
if they be neglected, & thus not doubting of
your readiness to comply, I bid you heartily
farewell resting your Loving Friend
